## Your inquiry about entry in the ECHA SCIP-Database for Endress+Hauser products

## Dear valued customer

With the amending of Directive 2008/98/EC on waste to (EU) 2018/851, manufacturers must provide information on SvHC (**S**ubstances of **v**ery **H**igh **C**oncern) in their products together with other information also to ECHA via the central database SCIP (**S**ubstances of **C**oncern **I**n articles as such or in complex objects (**P**roducts)).

As this requirement applies to all manufacturers and sales organizations that supply products to the EU, it also applies to Endress+Hauser.

Due to the large volume and the complexity of the information to be supplied a considerable amount of work is involved. We have started data maintenance in the SCIP database. Effected Endress+Hauser products you can find in the SCIP Datebase <a href="https://echa.europa.eu/scip-database">https://echa.europa.eu/scip-database</a> by searching with the main-ordercode (e.g.CML18, RIA16, COS22) as article identifier.

Endress+Hauser undertakes to comply with its legal obligations.
